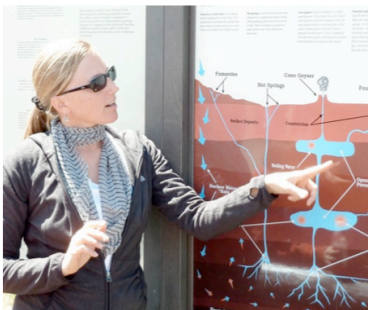

YNP Lower Loop Tour – approx 12hr Full Day with Grand Teton highlights

DETAILS: Tours will pass through GTNP with stops: Oxbow Bend and Jackson Lake Lodge. Stops on the YNP lower loop include: Old Faithful Geyser, historic Old Faithful Inn, Fountain Paint Pots (bubbling mud, colorful hot springs, steam vents & smaller geysers), Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone with views of Upper and Lower Falls, and historic Lake Hotel. Educational topics include: human history (native Americans, fur trappers, settlers, and tourism), National Park formation, flora, fauna, and complex geology (*how were those stunning mountains, lakes and rivers formed in GTNP? And yes... we are visiting one of the largest volcanoes in the world!*). We'll also have plenty of stops to photograph the beautiful scenery & abundant wildlife... and stretch our legs!

MODIFICATIONS: Tours can be modified to your needs, including **Wolf & Grizzly Discovery Center** in West Yellowstone MT and/or overnights in order to visit Yellowstone's **Upper Loop**

GRAND TETON National Park

GTNP Overview Tour – approx 5hr Sunrise / Sunset

DETAILS: ½ day tours are recommended over the shorter wildlife tour, so as to ensure travel through the major Grand Teton National Park roads... not only to look for wildlife, but also to allow for a complete educational and scenic overview. Stops may include: Mormon Row, Snake River Overlook, Oxbow Bend, Jackson Lake Lodge, String Lake, and Jenny Lake Overlook. Educational topics include: human history (native Americans, fur trappers, settlers, & tourism), National Park formation, geology (*how were those stunning mountains, lakes and rivers formed?*), flora & fauna. We'll also have plenty of stops to photograph the beautiful scenery & abundant wildlife and to stretch our legs

GTNP Complete Tour – approx 8hr Full Day

DETAILS: All details as listed in *GTNP Highlight Tour* with added stops for Signal Mountain Summit, Chapel of Transfiguration, Visitors' Center, lunch & shopping as desired

MODIFICATIONS: Jackson Lake boat rental; Jenny Lake boat ride w/un-guided Hidden Falls hike; Raptor Center tour; Teton Village Resort aerial tram; Snow King Resort activities; Town of Jackson tour; Schwabacher Landing

Fall Wildlife Tour – 4hr Sunrise / Sunset... during Elk Rut (Sept/Oct mating season)

DETAILS: Although wildlife cannot be guaranteed, this tour focuses on the Elk Rut during the autumn mating season, in order to watch/listen to the bulls bugle, fight, and keep control of their harems. Since private tours are customized to your needs, we can modify as you desire.
